

Quincy Credit Union Awards \$6,000 in Scholarships to Local Students

QUINCY, MA (June 4, 2025) – Quincy Credit Union (QCU) is proud to announce the recipients of its 2025 Scholarship Program. This year, QCU received 136 student applications, with five students selected based on their thoughtful essays describing how they contributed to their communities and what they gained from those experiences.

Now in its 20th year, the QCU Scholarship Program continues to support local students from area high schools and undergraduates currently attending accredited U.S. colleges or universities.

One student was awarded a \$2,000 scholarship in honor of William Phelan's 50 years of dedicated service to Quincy Credit Union. The four additional recipients each received a \$1,000 scholarship. Funds were deposited directly into each recipient's QCU account to assist with college expenses.

The students were recognized during an awards ceremony held on June 4 at the Quincy branch. Antonio Agcaoili, Chair of the Scholarship Committee, presented each student with a Certificate of Scholarship to include in their college portfolios.
